## RESPONSIBILITIES AND GUIDELINES FOR CLASSROOM TEACHERS

- 1. To conduct the classroom in accordance with the Public Schools Act, the Educational Administration Act, Turtle Mountain School Division Policy and regulations and procedural guidelines therein;
- 2. To maintain responsibility for ensuring the development of educational programing for all children on the classroom register;
- 3. To collect information from observation, informal assessment and diagnostic teaching to assist in the identification process of exceptional needs;
- 4. To consult with the school student services team so as to facilitate identification of the specific learning needs; through the classroom profile process;
- 5. To ensure the parent/guardian are notified of concern regarding student's needs and to acquire written parental permission for additional assessment when necessary;
- 6. To monitor the progress of the student's IEP and to request relevant professional assistance as required;
- 7. In conjunction with the student services team to regularly revise and maintain a written individual education plan for students identified as requiring extensive program modifications.
